MINNIES FOOD PANTRY

Provides a food pantry with eligibility based on TEXCAP income guidelines. Based on availability, pantry offers fresh meats, produce, dairy and non-perishable items. Required to complete recipient form, bring ID and verification, such as utility bill or social security card. Pantry is currently run as a drive through service and requires room in your vehicle trunk. The food pantry is open Wednesday-Saturday 8:30-11:30am and is closed every 5th Saturday.

THE STOREHOUSE OF COLLIN COUNTY

Provides food through Seven Loaves Food Pantry every Thursday 3:30-6:00pm and Saturday 8:30-11:00am, clothing through Joseph's coat by appointment only, other resources through Project Hope, and assistance in accessing available county social services. The pantry can be visited one a week and serves everyone, regardless of zip code. Joseph's Closet can be visited once every two months by appointment.

FRISCO FAMILY SERVICES

Provides food distribution, adult education for life skills classes, financial assistance, and additional supportive programs. Must live in Frisco or Frisco ISD. Requires a government ID, photo ID, copy of current lease or mortgage, copy of all household bills, proof of all income including benefits, and documentation of crisis – bills, medical, etc. to determine eligibility.

Provides food for individuals and families who live in Collin County. Requirements: proof of residency from the last 30 days (utility bill, landlord letter) and picture ID. The pantry operates Tuesdays 10am-2pm, Thursdays 6pm-8pm, and Saturdays 8am-12pm. Visits to the food pantry can be made once every 14 days.
